- CFSC Policy Initiatives Kate
  - Statements of strategic overview do we want to adopt?
  - Concern that statements may appear threatening?
  - o Build credibility as enabler, not competitor
  - Shifts focus from fuels only to climate and community
  - Shows who we are and where we're going and how we are going to make it happen
  - Use for advocacy
